



TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF C20, DUNTISH TO HAZELBURY BRYAN

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has made a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along the C20, DUNTISH TO HAZELBURY BRYAN between Duntish Cross and West Pleck Farm, Pleck Hill a distance of approximately 6,650 metres. The notice is needed to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise the likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 25th February 2019 and will remain in force for 5 days. It is anticipated that the works will be start on Monday 25 February and will be completed by Thursday 28 February 2019. The road will be closed between 09.00hrs and 16.00hrs daily: it will be open outside of these times.

This notice will enable Dorset County Council to carry out carriageway maintenance and resurfacing works.

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
