



URGENT TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF BOOKHAM LANE, BUCKLAND NEWTON

DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL has issued a Notice under Section 14 [2] of the Road Traffic Regulations Act 1984 as amended. All vehicles will be prohibited from proceeding along Bookham Lane, Buckland Newton from its junction with Brockhampton, Buckland Newton to Wreth Farm, Buckland Newton a distance of approximately 270 metres. The order is needed in order to comply with Health and Safety Regulations which require the provision of safe working areas and to minimise likelihood of danger to Highway Users. It will come into operation on the 27 November 2018 between 09:30 and 15:30 and remain in force for 5 days. However it is anticipated that the works will be completed by 27 November 2018.

This Notice will enable Openreach safe access to their over head network to restore customer service

The alternative route which will be sign posted is; Castle Lane - B3143 - Bookham Lane
